 - B. Living with a view toward glorifying one's death putting down Christ.
- III. "If we live, we live to the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord."
 - A. A Christian lives to glorify the Lord Jesus.
 - B. A Christian dies glorifying the Lord Jesus.
- IV. "So then, whether we live or whether we die, we are the Lord's."
 - A. Our lives are lived, owned by the Lord Jesus.
 - B. We die, owned by the Lord Jesus.
